Community Sport

Initiation Program

Mandatory for all on-ice instructional staff with Initiation Program Players 6 years old and under.

Coach Level

For all House League Head & Assistant Coaches, and for all Novice & Atom Competitive Head and Assistant Coaches – Full implementation by December 31st of the 2014-2015 season.

Competition Introduction

Development 1

For all Competitive team (B, A, AA) Head & Assistant Coaches of Minor Pee wee and older. - Full implementation by December 31st of the 2014-2015 season.

Development 2

Currently, this is only a professional development course and not a pre-requisite for H.P. 1

Competition Development

High Performance 1

For all AAA Head & Assistant Coaches and those interested in Provincial/National Championships - Full implementation by December 31st of the 2014-2015 season.

High Performance 2

For those interested in CIS and Similar National or International programs.

Must already be H.P. 1 Certified

Upon the completion of your course you are considered "Trained" and can coach with this status. To be certified by the Coaching Association of Canada you must complete the Making Ethical Decisions course on-line at www.coach.ca

Please note: You must take the course that corresponds with the level you are coaching, having a different level does not exempt you from taking the required course.
