

COACH STREAM CLINIC COURSE OUTLINE

All Head Coaches at the house league level are required to have the Coach Stream Course. The Assistant coaches are not required to take the course but it is ***highly recommended***.

All Assistant Coaches in competitive hockey must have their Coach Stream certification.

Welcome to the first level of the Hockey Canada's NCCP – National Coaching Certification program. This program is designed to give you, the coach, the tools to effectively coach a team. To complete this program you will be required to **complete** 3 core components to be fully certified as a Coach Stream Coach and also to move on to take the Developmental 1 course.

- Seminar Pre-task
- In-class work
- Post-class course workbook

Before attending the in-class portion of this course you will be required to complete this pre-clinic task. These tasks are designed to kick-start your learning experience by making you think about some of the key issues facing the hockey coach. There are no right or wrong answers this task will be reviewed in the classroom session.

Your growth as a coach depends solely on your willingness to learn more about coaching and pursue the opportunities that are made available to you. This learning log should be used not only to prepare for this seminar but can also be used to guide your coaching in the future.

Day 2: 9am – 5 pm

Communication Action Plan - This basically covers supporting the players in the Team Environment.

Teaching Skills Action Plan - Teaching the different skills of the game such as:

1. Technical Skills - skills of the body
2. Tactical Skills - skills of the mind
3. Team Skills - the coordinated skills of the team

Preparing for a Practice Session - Stating the goals of the practice, and key teaching points.

Game Day Action Plan - Preparing and planning for your game.

There is also 2 hours of “on-ice” instruction to show the coaches hands on, what was taught in the classroom.
