

# So you're going to be a Head Coach?

The chart below outlines the  $\underline{\textbf{REQUIRED}}$  courses/requirements for the level of hockey you will be coaching.

Competitive Minor Peewee – Major Midget Rep B, A, AA	Respect in Sport Make Ethical Decisions (Competition-Introduction) Development 1	On-Line On-Line In Class (2 days)
Competitive Major Peewee AAA– Major Midget AAA	Respect in Sport Make Ethical Decisions (Competition- Development) Leading Drug Free Sport Managing Conflict High Performance 1	On-Line On-Line On-Line In Class (36 hours)

Having attended and completing a different course does not preclude anyone from having to have the REQUIRED course. The courses are set up to teach the coach the required information to coach athletes at the different levels of their growth and development. None of these courses are higher levels of certification; they are simply different areas of knowledge.

### Example 1:

A coach already has Development 1 certification but is going to coach a Novice A Rep team this season. That Coach MUST take the HU - ONLINE Coach  $\frac{1}{2}$  and the Coach 2 – Coach Level Course in class.

### Example 2:

Last season you coached a Bantam AAA team and you took the High Performance 1 Course. This year you are coaching a Peewee AA team. You will need to take the Development 1 course.

## Example 3:

You have Development 1 certification but are going to coach a Peewee, Bantam, Or Midget House League Team, you are eligible to Coach with the Development 1 Certification.

#### Notes:

- The Development 1 course has a mandatory Post Task Assignment and a Field Evaluation that must be completed and passed to receive full certification. Coaches are permitted to assume their roles while the process is taking place.
- The High Performance 1 Course has an extensive Post Clinic Assignment and a Field Evaluation that must be completed and passed in order to achieve full certification at this level. Coaches are permitted to assume their roles while the process is taking place.
- Development 1 and High Performance 1 Certification is subject to Certification Maintenance Requirements. Please visit the <u>Maintenance of Certification</u> page for more details.
